The Clouded Apollo is a butterly species of the family of swallowtail butterflies. They inhabit in all European countries. In Latvia they appear rarely and only in the valleys of some rivers in Kurzeme. The swallowtail butterflies are usually large however in Latvia they can reach only13 cm. The adult swallowtails sip nectar, sometimes water or juice of trees and fruit.

The Brown-Lipped Snail is a species of air-breathing land snail. It is one of the most common species of land snail in Europe and it is among the largest and best-known snails in Western Europe. They live in shrubs and open woods, dunes, gardens and roadside. The colour of the shell is very variable: it can be reddish, brownish, yellow or whitish, with or without one or more dark-brown colour bands.

The European pond turtles are medium size turtles and they can be 12 to 38 cm long. Their shell is brown with a hint of green and yellow spots. The pond turtles eat all kind of small water anor land creatures.

The turtles prefer to live in wetlands surrounded by a large proportion of natural, wooded, landscape.

Septembris September



The Stock Doves are the largest among the pigeons. They are usually light grey or brown, often with a white head or neck labels and they have got green or purple spots on their necks and chests. Their length is 28 - 32 cm but the streched wings are 60 - 66 cm width. The Stock Doves weight from 250 - 300g. They eat seeds of grass, weeds, grain and berries.

Decembris December



The Pine Martens populate in Europe. They usually live in thick forests. The Pine Martens are about the size of a domestic cat with a 25 cm long, bushy tail. But their weight is 0,8 - 2,5 kg. Their fur colour varies from dark brown to light brown. The Pine Martens hunt a big variety of small animals - rodents, squirrels, bunnies, birds, insects, frogs.
